

Requirements Lists when on CPM Shoots

NOTE: These lists may change for certain locations

If selected for a CPM Shoot – please check all Operational & Tactical Plans for current information.

Equipment:

- Permits and Authorisations {see below}
- Maps or Compass {may be Provided by PARKS VIC}
- GPS Unit – with Map layer {may be provided by PARKS VIC – if so, DO NOT adjust settings}
- Portable trunk radio, UHF Radio and spare battery, Mobile Phone
- Binoculars
- Trunk radio / Mobile Phone
- Firearm {Calibre designated for each shoot – these may vary}
 - **NOTE:** Firearm **must** be sighted in prior to operation
- Hunter Diary {Provided by PARKS VIC}
- DNA sample kit
- Shooting Stick/Firearm Sling
- Hand held Spotlight & Battery Pack
- Spotlight charging equipment
- Spotlight Filters – rotated to avoid familiarisation
- Hunting Knife
- First Aid Kit, including snake bite kit

Clothing:

- Long Trousers/Gaiters
- Sturdy Boots
- Blaze Orange Vest or cap
- Ear protection
- Eye Protection

Permits and Authorisations:

- Section 37 Authorisation
- Firearms Licence
- Authority to Control Wildlife Permit {Provided by PARKS VIC}
- R24 Permit {Provided by PARKS VIC}

Participant conduct:

- **NO** alcohol or drugs to be consumed at any time during the operation
- Maintain a civil disposition at all times during the operation
- Shooting be suspended if a member(s) of the public is encountered during the operation. Operations controller to be notified and is only person who can reinstate shooting permission. Shooting will resume once the person(s) are outside the firing zone (as described in the Firearms Safety Code).
- Any conflict or potential conflict with a member of the public is referred to the Parks Victoria Operations Controller.
- Any contact with members of the media is to be referred to the Parks Victoria Operations Controller.
